<b>1</b>	<input type="checkbox"/>	<p><b>Current Level 2 Certification</b></p> <p>Officials may not move to Level 3 without first being certified as a Level 2 official.</p>
<b>2</b>	<input type="checkbox"/>	<p><b>Current US Lacrosse membership with Official participation</b></p> <p><a href="http://www.uslacrosse.org/membership/member-portal.aspx">http://www.uslacrosse.org/membership/member-portal.aspx</a> Join/Renew or sign in.</p>
<b>3</b>	<input type="checkbox"/>	<p><b>Attend classroom training</b></p> <p>Your Certified Trainer will conduct the training for your area. Depending on where you live you may be scheduled into one class or several classes.</p> <p>Contact your <a href="#">Sub-District Coordinator</a> for information on upcoming trainings.</p>
<b>4</b>	<input type="checkbox"/>	<p><b>Pass the Level 3 Field Evaluation</b></p> <p>No time limit. Should be completed as soon as possible after your classroom training. Local Certified Observer conducts the evaluation using the <a href="#">US Lacrosse Level 3 Evaluation Form</a>.</p>
<b>5</b>	<input type="checkbox"/>	<p><b>Pass either the NFHS or NCAA Rules test with at least a 90% on the US Lacrosse Central Hub.</b></p> <p>All Level 3 Officials must demonstrate mastery of the rules. The NCAA and NFHS tests available at <a href="https://uslacrosse.arbitersports.com/front/108525/Test">https://uslacrosse.arbitersports.com/front/108525/Test</a>. The rules used in your area will dictate which test you need to complete.</p>
